SEAS IEP enables Special Education to:

- Customize forms incorporating district and state standards,
- Create rules driving timelines compliant with state and federal laws.

Forms Review:

- Forms were reviewed by the Core Implementation Team comprised of 17 staff from different areas and the Community Advisory Committee (CAC).
- Forms were developed based on feedback from various groups.
- Currently performing system and forms testing, an ongoing process.


Timeline:

- District Go Live: September 6, 2016


