



Language Other Than English Proficiency Certification

- D 4. The student completed 2 or more years of formal schooling abroad in a LOTE in grade 6 or higher.

- D 5. The student completed an oral and written exam in a LOTE administered by a fully-proficient speaker of the student's language, with a proficiency level equivalent to two or more years of college-prep study.

- D 6. The student's LOTE proficiency was certified via college or university assessment.
